AREADANZA's dance study holidays are designed for students aged 11 to 18 who already practice dance. They will take place at the prestigious LORETTO SCHOOL (www.loretto.com), located near the beautiful city of Edinburgh, in a green and peaceful setting, immersed in the enchanting and lush Scottish countryside. Here, students live in a safe, secure, and constantly supervised environment, ideal for studying, having fun, and developing independently. An intensive week with English lessons in the morning with native teachers and dance lessons in the afternoon, with the constant presence of Italian, English, Spanish, and Portuguese staff and tutors to ensure maximum comfort and safety.



LORETTO SCHOOL is a charming historic complex, entirely designed to accommodate children and provide them with the necessary recreational spaces. Surrounded by lush Scottish nature, just a few kilometers from Edinburgh, it extends over 350,000 square meters of buildings, sports fields, and green spaces, completely fenced and monitored 24/7. The facility is equipped with the highest standards of comfort and offers a theater, a gym, a canteen and various common recreational areas, both indoors and outdoors, where other organized activities will take place during the stay.



For students over 18 years old, the option is the prestigious LSE BANKSIDE HOUSE located in the center of London, just a few steps from the city's main attractions. Allí can study and have fun, staying in a bed and breakfast. The intensive week includes English classes in the morning with native teachers and dance classes in the afternoon, with enough free time to explore the city and its locality.

Former Master and Principal Dancer of the Company, he is currently a teacher at the Ballet School of the Teatro alla Scala in Milan. Born in Milan, he graduated from the Ballet School of the Teatro alla Scala and attended the advanced training course at the Choreographic School of the Bolshoi Theatre in Moscow for three years. In 1982, he joined the ballet company of the great Milanese theater, becoming a soloist and then Principal Dancer of the company in 1984. In 1994, he began his career as a teacher and assistant director to Ms. A. Prina at the Ballet School of La Scala, subsequently becoming Ballet Master and Professor of the Ballet Company under the direction of F. Olivieri, E. Terabust, and M. Vaziev. Throughout his career, he has collaborated with the greatest international choreographers, including R. Nureyev, J. Kylián, W. Forsythe, A. Ailey, R. Petit, and others. He was co-founder, teacher, and resident choreographer of the AIDA Training Center. Since 2023, he has been a teacher for the Advanced Training Course and ADAM program at the Accademia Teatro alla Scala.

Dancer, choreographer, and teacher, she began studying classical and modern dance in 1978, specializing with several renowned masters and passing the ISTD exams in London. Winner of several scholarships—including those from the Lazio Region, the Tuscany Region, and the École Supérieure de Danse “Rosella Hightower” in Cannes—she moved to Rome to continue her professional training. Since 1993, she has dedicated herself to teaching and, since 2009, has directed the Areadanza school, where she teaches classical and contemporary dance. She collaborated with the Teatro alla Scala in Milan as assistant ballet master in the production of “A Midsummer Night’s Dream” and has participated in national theater and musical productions. In 2011, she received the Anita Bucchi Award, sponsored by the MIBAC and the Teatro dell’Opera di Roma. She is frequently invited as a judge and teacher in workshops and competitions in Europe, Russia, Ukraine, and South America. Author of original creations such as SER and Io e il Grillo, performed in Italy, Spain and Greece, she combines in her choreographies technical rigor, creativity and contamination between genres, transmitting to young dancers a complete and contemporary vision of dance.

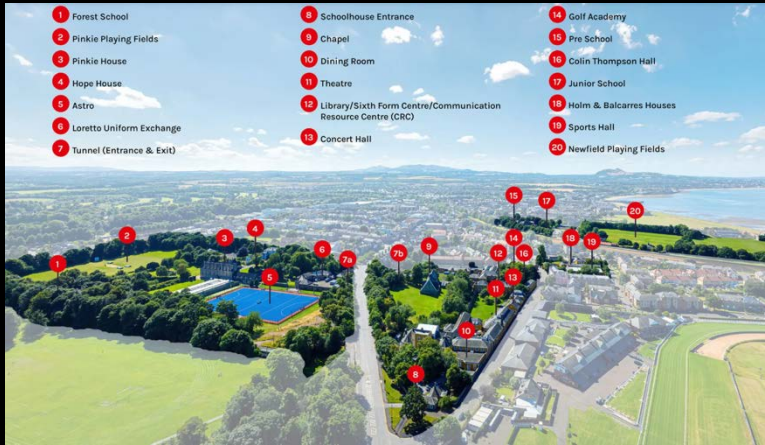


Alessia CIRICOSTA

LORETTO is one of Scotland's top boarding schools, and the entire facility has been designed to welcome and support students. During the summer holidays, the management makes the college available for sports and cultural events, including those from other countries, maintaining the same attention and rigor to the supervision and safety of its guests. EDINBURGH (11-18 years old) 18-25 July 2027:

Sunday: arrival at the campus in double or individual rooms, full board/ **From Monday until Friday:** English classes from 9:00 to 12:00 – dance classes from 1:30 to 18:00 / **Saturday:** daily excursion to discover Edinburgh, with food included / **Sunday:** departure from the campus.

Everyone will enjoy moments of coexistence and recreational activities in the evenings.

- Balance, by April 30th, with the following reason: *participant's name and surname – DANCE your ENGLISH balance.*

While reiterating that children will be under constant supervision 24 hours a day for the entire duration of their stay, the following documentation is required upon registration:

- Liability release signed by parents;
- Health insurance coverage;
- Medical certificate of fitness to practice dance.
